

**T**HE ART INSTITUTE OF CHICAGO was incorporated May 24, 1879, for the "founding and maintenance of schools of art and design, the formation and exhibition of collections of objects of art, and the cultivation and extension of the arts of design by any appropriate means." The Museum building upon the Lake Front, first occupied in 1893, is open to the public every week day from 9 to 6, Sundays from 12:15 to 10 p. m. Admission is free to members and their families at all times, and free to all upon Wednesdays, Saturdays, Sundays and public holidays.

The Art School, in the same building, includes departments of Drawing, Painting, Sculpture, Illustration, Decorative Designing, Normal Instruction, and Architecture.

All friends of the Art Institute are invited to become members. Annual Members pay a fee of ten dollars a year. Life Members pay one hundred dollars and are thenceforth exempt from dues. Governing Members pay one hundred dollars upon election and twenty-five dollars a year thereafter. Upon the payment of four hundred dollars, Governing Members become Governing Life Members and are thenceforth exempt from dues. All receipts from life memberships are invested and the income only expended.



The Exhibition Committee of the Municipal Art League is a standing committee composed of representatives of various organizations which are federated for the purpose of encouraging art in the city of Chicago, but which otherwise preserve their independence.

This committee assists as far as possible the exhibition of works of Chicago artists, arranges the receptions given by the different organizations, manages the proposed prizes of these societies, and annually purchases a work of art for the Municipal Art Gallery.

**MUNICIPAL ART GALLERY.** In order to strengthen the excellent plan by which clubs and individuals purchase works of art at the Annual Exhibition of works by artists of Chicago and vicinity, the Exhibition Committee in 1902 voted to establish and maintain a Municipal Art Gallery to be formed of works of artists who are or have been active in the artistic life of Chicago, its object being the encouragement of works of art worthy to be in a public gallery. A committee known as the Special Picture Fund Committee endeavors to raise the sum of at least \$500.00 annually, to add to a permanent picture fund, from which is purchased each year a work of art provided the jury finds some work of art of sufficient merit and importance to justify the purchase.

The purchase for this gallery is made by a jury composed of the Chairman of the Exhibition Committee and ten members including the Chairman of the Picture Fund Committee.
