along, for they want a large crowd of young people, so I now hope to see you once more this week.

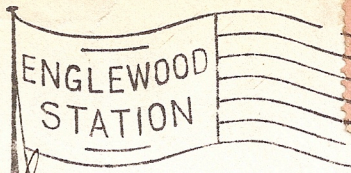
How is this dear boy of mine feeling, at any rate I trust this letter will find you in perfect health.
