you call.

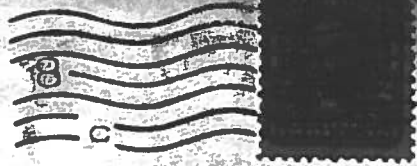
I am not going to church either
