but I guess I better shut up

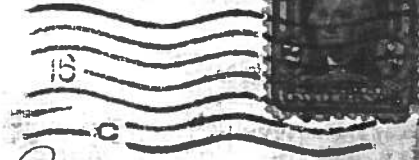
stop about the girls for he might
