If you get around that way to me to pick it up for me and send it on.

You asked about how long it takes for your letters to reach me - usually one month.

Please send me the addresses of Don and Barbara and also Chaplain MacKay. Thanks much for Barbara's picture - double thanks for that.

I'm really feeling fine. Took a good hot shower at the Red Cross this morning and ate plenty of candy and tangerines this afternoon.
