Dear Mom, Dad and all,

Just came back to the office from church and I'm feeling as though I want to write a letter even though there is no special news. Your letters are coming through fine and gashed full of news for me.

The chaplain here is very good and the services are very well attended for G.I. This morning there were about 400 in the "congregation".

Last night I had a treat too. A Quartermaster Major and Lt. Col. live below me and invited me down for a picture show and a feed. Had a couple of G.I.'s run the movie projector and then tied on the feed bag about 10 o'clock. Since the G.M. serves the rationing they don't stand short on anything.

I'm feeling too well these days. Still trying to swing a goin' home deal but no definite news as yet.
