your letter came a couple days ago, Mig. Thanks for all the news. Nothing exciting happens here - the grapes get ripe and I eat 'em, it rains occasionally, etc and life goes on.

Last night I attended a U.S.O. stage production - The Parrotle of Wimpole Street. That was very good. I followed it with two glassfulls of ice cream and a coke before hitting the hay for an extra hours sleep. We turned our clocks back one hour last night.

The chapel service was packed this morning. Must have been at least 500 or 600 attending.

At the present time I'm trying to swing another trip to home for a few days. Also trying to wiggle into a trip home, of course, but things seem so undecided. I'd like to be back for this Christmas.
