the location of the new proposed state university campus in Ventura County (front page Dec. 1) and then Tuesday seeing the large flames lapping up the hills over the city of Ventura, I was wondering why no proposal has been made to crown those beautiful hills with our new state university. Most of the land probably is owned by city, county and state governments, and could be given free to promote the beginning of construction of the university.
