I just figured out why Google gives you nothing for the Evanston Swedish Baptist Church: because they changed their name in the 1920s to Calvary Baptist Church! Once I figured that out I was able to go back and find several articles about the church's history (from different anniversary celebrations) in the Evanston Review, which isn't digitized, but which we have bound in print copies at the library. It doesn't seem that any one article focuses on that older history, but each mentions it -- and often include different details. As such, I'm sending all of them, scanned in the attached document, for you to make what you will with. There were a few other articles about Calvary Baptist that I could send, but they're articles that make no mention of the connection to Swedish Baptist.

I just checked and Calvary Baptist has no historical info on their website: http://livinghopeofcalvary.org/
