He was a person zealously devoted to his work. As children, we ^{considerably} less of ~~the~~ ^{patients} than would be typical of an ordinary family. We spent 9 months of the year away in boarding school & even when home on holidays Dad was often in the country attending to his pastoral duties. Consequently, he seems to me a solemn & ^{remote} ~~person~~ ^{person} until years later when I returned to China. ^{Later} I got to know him. Then I realized ~~his~~ that his quiet exterior hid a sense of humor, a great deal of wisdom & uncommon patience. ^{Church} members would come in to see him wanting to make a ~~report~~ ^{report} but in Chinese fashion would discuss extraneous subjects. Dad ~~was~~ always kept his composure & ~~wished them out~~. He was a severe person though not placid or dispassionate.

An example of how he was revered by the city fathers of Kiolesia was the memorial given by the city after his death. You know ^{more about it} ~~it~~.

Kate during World War II ^{Margaret} she served in an emergency clinic attached to several firms which transhipped war materials to the Pacific theatre. Her husband an electrical engineer was in charge of the electrical department in the same concern.

In the last 10 yrs of M's life she lived in a desert community working occasionally when the need arose. She joined in community activities, was President of the Women's Club & won prizes for flower arrangements ^{shows sponsored by Garden Club} for the Garden Club. She was kindly, spirited person, kind & generous & much beloved in Yucca Valley. On her death in April 25th 1959 her friends contributed toward a memorial in her honor for the local Hosp. She was buried in Inverly Home Valms.

She returned to the US after 4 1/2 yrs in Europe. She specialized in Pediatric N. & served for many years in CH in Boston LA

She attended her education at the U of C, Sask. where she earned a Bachelors degree in Science.

Her last post was Dir. at the HMS for C & M in Sask. The assignment in collaboration with the B of M & the U of C was to develop a residential program for children in C & M which would provide them a concentrated physical, occup. & speech therapies & spec. schol. The Home had previously treated children with Poles. The new program required renovated & new buildings &

a much expanded staff. Not only was ~~the HMS~~ a treatment centre for children but it served also as a clinical ^{expansion} ~~expansion~~ for medical & nursing stud. therapists, and teachers interested in spec. education.

She retired after 5 yrs & now lives in California.
