Cary was there, so the

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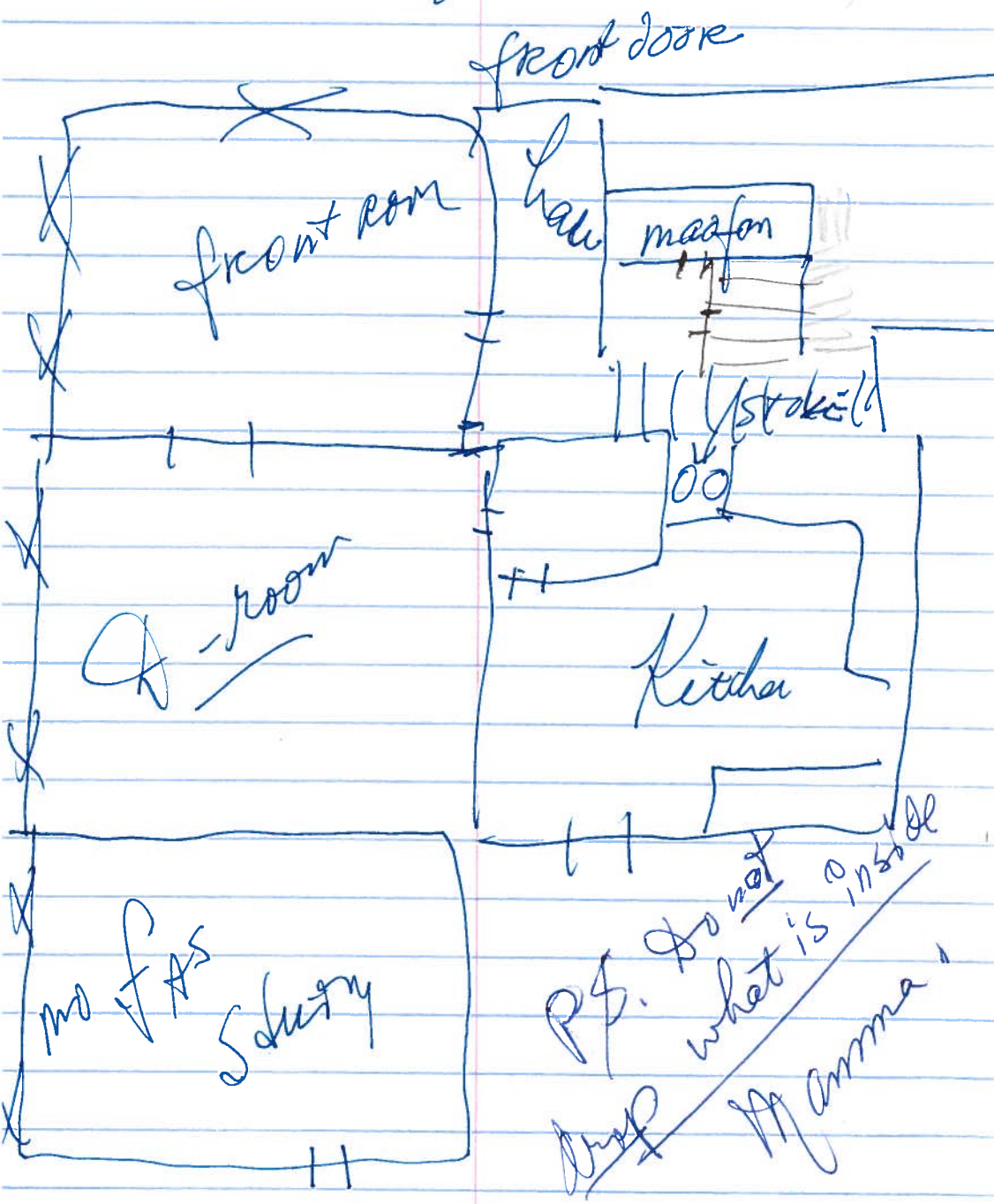
prices came down as he is
