

Chen K'ang-fa's letter.

Kiaohsien Oct. 10th 1938.

Dear Miss Chen:

Your letter of 4th inst. about your mothers debt to me is received.

I understand that it is not easy for her to pay the money, but I know she has both a good house and several acres (Mu) of land. Your father gave me a certificate on the latter as security for the money. If selling this, it will more than cover the debt.

Personally I need the money just now and as Mr. Fan stands as the security man and has to pay the money if your mother is failing to do so, he is naturally anxious about it.

Trust however your mother will be able to manage to pay it before long so neither I or Mr. Fan will have any extra trouble.
