I am getting near my end of staying here. I may leave next Tuesday. I may stop over one night in Mjölby. Mr Lagerborg of Topcka has come home once more to see his relatives. He is 84 now. We visited his family in Topcka 1933. His wife was one of Dad's relatives. My next stop may be Örebro. You may remember one of our missionaries Mr Thörng was shot at on the road to Weibsiem and died May 12<sup>th</sup>. He was buried in T. May 17 in T. They had one little son borne on his 50 years celebration. He was run over by a motor car last Sunday and died last Tuesday. He is to be buried on the 17<sup>th</sup> like his father. I feel I must attend his funeral for his mother's sake. Gerta may go to so she may meet me at Örebro. Mr Thörng is broken down with this new sorrow.
