Dear Len,

Enclosed is a completed version of a chart that I started right after your last letter and sent up to Seattle for completion. It took awhile to get it passed from my aunt Helen to her two brothers and their wives, but it came back today with every piece of information filled out. As it comes from original sources what is in this chart supersedes anything that I have sent you previously. Consequently, you'll have three important corrections to make involving changing the names you've assigned to certain numbers. They are:

- ① 1.1.6.3.4.1.1.3.1. should belong to Nathan Timothy Jameson, not his twin brother, Casey John Jameson. Casey should be assigned Nathan's old number, 1.1.6.3.4.1.1.3.2.
- ② 1.1.6.3.4.1.3.2.1. should belong to Marc Aaron Saunders, not his younger sister, Jessica Michelle Saunders. Jessica should be assigned Marc's old number, 1.1.6.3.4.1.3.2.2.
- ③ 1.1.6.3.4.1.3.4.1. should belong to Jesse Lee Saunders, not his younger sister April Rae Saunders. April should be ~~assigned~~ assigned Jesse's old number, 1.1.6.3.4.1.3.4.2.

There might be a few more discrepancies between this chart and the computerized listing that you sent to me. I sent it to Seattle without making a copy of it and my relatives have neglected to return it. Therefore, I'm unable to make a careful comparison between the two. When you are able to add this information to what I gave you earlier, please send me a copy, so I can see exactly what we've got.

I believe that we have everything we could want on

actual family members. The only deficiency is when it come:  
to spouses. I still don't know the maiden names of ~~three~~  
of my cousins-in-law, the wives of Thomas Charles Saunders,  
and Robert Eric Saunders. That would be pretty easy to get.  
However, if you really think we need birthdates on all the  
current spouses that's a pretty big project. Between my sisters  
and my cousins there are nine existing marriages. I believe  
I've only given you birthdates on three spouses. That leaves  
six to get birthdates on the spouses.

A lot depends on your intentions. Do you want this to be a  
record of what exists now or do you intend to keep it current?  
Today my oldest second cousin is 21. Behind her are 17  
. spouses, children and occupations. That's a lot of changes  
to keep track of. I may make it one of my hobbies to be the  
family historian and keep track of it all. I believe I am well  
enough known and well enough liked to pull it off. It means  
keeping in touch with people at least once a year, so they'll  
keep me posted on what their kids are doing. You and I can  
do one of two things. We can make the best record of what we  
have now and you send me the final copy of it. Since I  
have a computer, I'll put it all on 3x5 cards and keep  
them in a box. When there's a change, I take out the  
and update it. The other thing would be for you to keep the  
in your computer. I'll send you new information, when I get  
and you send me a copy of the updated record occasionally. What
