Dear Len,

Enclosed is a completed version of a chart that I started right after your last letter and sent up to Seattle for completion. It took awhile to get it passed from my aunt Helen to her two brothers and their wives, but it came back today with every piece of information filled out. As it comes from original sources what is in this chart supercedes anything that I have sent you previously. Consequently, you'll have three important corrections to make involving changing the names you've assigned to certain numbers. They are:

- ① 1.1.6.3.4.1.1.3.1. should belong to Nathan Timothy Jameson, not his twin brother, Casey John Jameson. Casey should be assigned Nathan's old number, 1.1.6.3.4.1.1.3.2.
- ② 1.1.6.3.4.1.3.2.1. should belong to Marc Aaron Saunders, not his younger sister, Jessica Michelle Saunders. Jessica should be assigned Marc's old number, 1.1.6.3.4.1.3.2.2.
- ③ 1.1.6.3.4.1.3.4.1. should belong to Jesse Lee Saunders, not his younger sister April Rae Saunders, April should be ~~assigned~~ assigned Jesse's old number, 1.1.6.3.4.1.3.4.2.

There might be a few more discrepancies between this chart and the computerized listing that you sent to me. I sent it to Seattle without making a copy of it and my relative have neglected to return it. Therefore, I'm unable to make a careful comparison between the two. When you are able to add this information to what I gave you earlier, please send me a copy, so I can see exactly what we've got.

actual family members.
