Across the main street is the only remaining old school building. I took some pictures of it. Across from there is the "field" which is now filled with apartment buildings. As I walked up and down these streets and alleys it made me realize that this was home -- and by chance or providence the school decided to put me up in this hotel right near our home! Isn't that cool?!

I pulled out the old map of Jiaozhou that Lally had made for us a few years ago -- and I will go and see if I can figure out where Siguan (Farmor and Farfar's house) would have been. It has to be within a stone's throw from the hotel! I think that old Feng could probably help me identify the approximate location of some of these places.

You know the song "We're standing on holy ground"! Well, today I felt that I was walking on holy ground! That melody kept ringing through my mind and I found myself humming as I walked along! "I'm standing (walking) on holy ground, and I know there are angels all around......for we are standing in His presence on holy ground"! Never have I felt it so strongly -- that THIS is where we lived and played as young kids. I truly felt the presence of "those who have gone before us" -- Farmor, Farfar, Mother and Dad, Oscar and Hellen, and, of course, us kids.
